LITIGATION UPDATE

You may or may not be aware that Glossbrenner is part of a litigation process with 49 other Eastern PA Conference churches. In June of 2022, Glossbrenner felt we did not share the same beliefs and values as the United Methodist Church based on actions taken by the General Conference. It was decided to use a provision developed at the 2019 General Conference to exit the UMC graciously. We have been involved in this litigation that is asking the Eastern PA Conference to allow us to leave without all of the strings and expenses imposed, which other United Methodist Conferences did not place on churches interested in disaffiliation. On Friday, March 7, the Judge ruled in favor of the churches in 2 of the 3 counts. This means that the litigation will be allowed to go to trial. Much work still needs to be done, and I will keep you updated on any other developments. In the meantime, continue to pray for all involved in this process. Once it is clear as to Glossbrenner's role in all of this, we will hold another Congregational Meeting to discuss the future path of this church.
