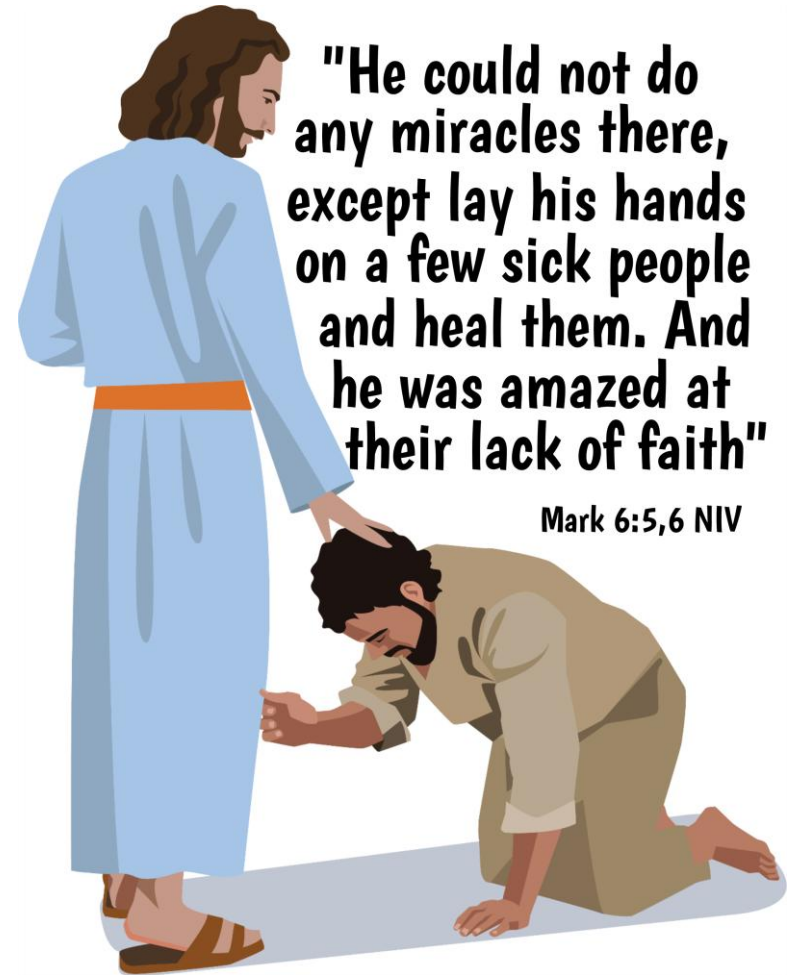


**PLEASE JOIN US IN PRAYER FOR:** (Week of 5-17-26)

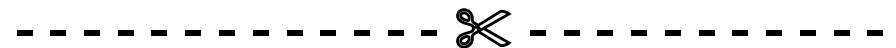
