# CONGRATULATIONS TO THE GRADUATES!

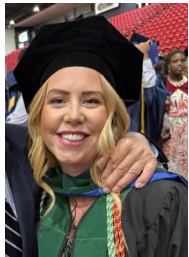
The following students were recognized on Sunday, May 31, during the morning worship service. Our best wishes to all the graduates. May God be with them as they begin a new chapter in their life.

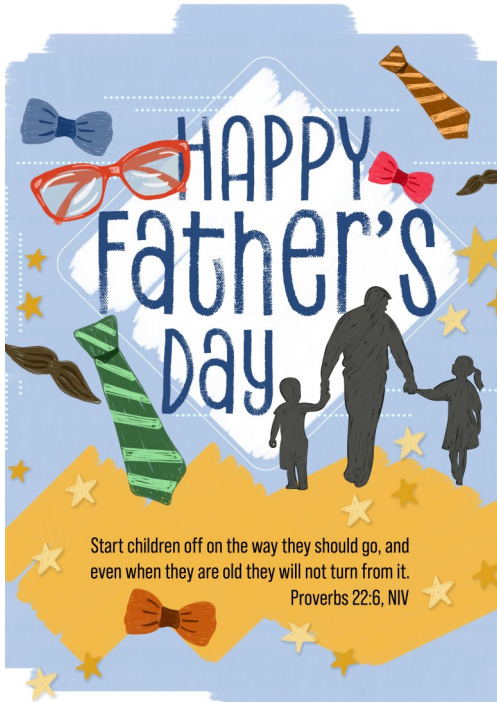
